In a project, BCF in partnership with Kuwait State and Ronahi Foundation provided 13, 948 families with blankets and food parcels.



Swedish Human Bridge organization incorporation with BCF provided special medical instruments for children to Raparin Hospital in Erbil. In the other hand, they distributed clothes, shoes, and other winter aids to the Syrian refugees in Kawrgosk camp.



In a partnership project, the BCF and Emirates Red Crescent distributed clothes, blankets, and food parcels to 19,723 families in Akre and Kawrgosk refugee camps, and Kirkuk IDPs in Erbil Hiran City and IDPs in Harsham camp.



Barzani Charity Foundation provided food parcels, health aids, school bags, blankets, mattress, and stoves to seven families in Mergasor town. They also assisted a disabled person with a wheelchair, stove, crutch, walker, toilet seat, and bedstead.



After an electronic shock caused a fire, 16 Iraqi IDP tents burned in Harsham camp, BCF and Emirates Red Crescent distributed stoves, fridges, and food parcels to the affected families.



In a partnership project between the BCF and LDS, they assisted 19 disabled persons with wheelchairs and other aids. Later, a seminar was presented regarding the usage of the equipment.





On February 11, 2019, aiming at discussing the living condition of refugees and lack of services, a delegation of the BCF visited Mr. Nufel Baha Musa the Minister of Immigration in Iraq.

In the meeting, in the Ministry Office in Baghdad, the refugees' living condition was highlighted. Mr. Nufel appreciated the BCF's attempts in the service of refugees. "The BCF has a great role in helping the refugees and Iraqi ethnics in particular." Said the Minister of Immigration. They decided to have more collaboration in order to reduce the refugees' sorrows inside and outside the camps.



For discussing the current humanitarian condition, a delegation from Barzani Charity Foundation headed Musa Ahmad the Head of the BCF, visited Kuwait and met some humanitarian organization. The BCF delegation went to Zakat House and greeted by Xalid Al-Jabry Director Deputy of the foundation and Adil Xalid Director of the organization's Foreign Affairs.

In the meeting, in Kuwait, the BCF delegation expressed the foundation's and Kurdi's gratitude to the Zakat House for all the efforts and charitable activities and they wished for the continuation of their projects for the refugees, IDPs, and needy people in Kurdistan Region.

Further, the Head of BCF met Mr. Aqel Al-Mansoor

Director of the Iraqi Commission for Human Rights. Human rights and obstacles facing humanitarian works in Iraq were the main subjects of the meeting. In the near future, they will sign a collaboration agreement between the Barzani Charity Foundation and the High Commission of Human Rights.

In his continuous meetings in Baghdad, Mr. Ahmad Head of BCF paid a visit to Dr. Ahmad Al-Abaede, Iraqi Minister of Sports and Youth. "The charitable works of the foundation have left its mark on the human heart rather than papers. The foundation's works have been a great opportunity for the Iraqi people to forget what they have been through," Dr. Al-Abaede told the BCF's delegation.



On February 13, 2019, a delegation from BCF headed by Musa Ahmad, Head of the foundation, visited Kuwait and met Dr. Hilal Al-Sayer, Head of the Kuwait Red Crescent, to discuss the humanitarian condition in Iraq. In the meeting, the head of BCF appreciated the humanitarian activities of Kuwait Red Crescent. «It is an honor to contribute with the Kuwait Red Crescent. Barzani Charity Foundation provides more assist and support to the IDPs and refugees in Iraq to improve their life condition,» Musa Ahmad, head of the BCF said. «Human crisis and the number of IDPs and refugees are increasing daily. The Total number of IDPs and refugees is 1,400,000 people,» he added. In the other hand, Al-Sayer, Head of the Kuwait Red Crescent appreciated the humanitarian activities by the BCF. «BCF successfully contributed with Kuwait Red Crescent to deliver aid to Iraqi IDPs in order to reduce their tragedies,» Al-Sayer, Head of the Kuwait Red Crescent mentioned.

In a project, Nineveh office of BCF distributed various gifts and stationaries to 350 orphans in the orphanage and the children on the right side of Mosul.





Emirates Red Crescent in coordination with BCF assisted 5800 families, who are living in a bad condition on Sinjar mountain, with clothes and flour.



In a partnership project, Kuwait State, BCF, and Runahi Foundation distributed blankets and food parcels to 13,948 families inside and outside the IDP camps.



The BCF in collaboration with some charitable people provided aid to 372 fatherless families in Duhok governorate for February.



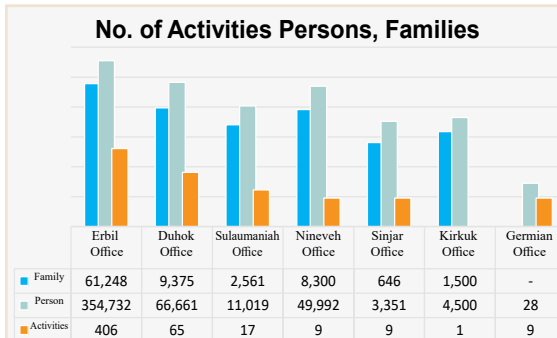
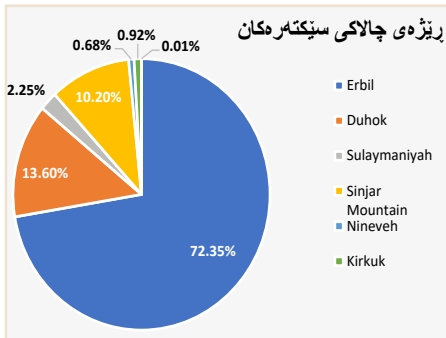
Education Sector of BCF distributed bags and stationaries to 298 Rojava refugee students in Sarekan School in Baziyah, Sulaymaniyah.

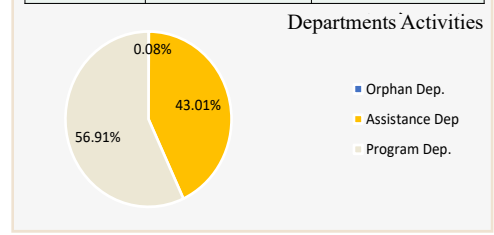
